What does Save the Family Do?

Save the Family, a 501 (C) 3, nonprofit, nondenominational organization provides transitional housing, case management, and supportive services to homeless families with children in the metropolitan Phoenix area. Since its inception in 1988 Save the Family has literally changed the lives of thousands of families and introduced the children in those families to a new life off of the streets and out of abusive situations. Historically, three fourths of the clients in the Save the Family program are victims of domestic violence. Statistics show that the average age of a homeless person is just 9 years old and the fastest growing segment of the homeless population are families with children. Save the Family's goal has always been to help homeless families achieve financial, parental and personal self-sufficiency, thus decreasing their dependence on government support. Save the Family currently have **159** total transitional and affordable rental units in the East Valley and Scottsdale housing **857** individuals.

Save the Family depends on the generous assistance of hundreds of volunteers to renovate and maintain our properties, as well as monetary donations, contributions of furniture, clothing, non-perishable food items, and household goods to furnish our homes.
